COLEBROOKE PARISH COUNCIL: CEMETERY RULES

Details of memorials must be submitted to the Council for approval before being erected

- 1. New memorials may not be more than 3ft in height
- 2. Permanent wooden memorials are not allowed
- 3. Kerbstones may not be placed around the graves
- 4. No trees or shrubs may be planted on the graves
- 5. Wreaths or flowers placed on graves which have become withered or decayed must be taken away or the Council will remove them
- 6. Glass or other fragile containers may not be used for flowers unless forming part of a memorial.
- 7. To assist in grass cutting the Council may level grave mounds after a suitable time has elapsed and in consultation with the family where possible

Cemetery Charges are set by the Council annually and are located on the Council noticeboards and on the Council website.
